WHERE: Swimming pool "Daniela Samuele", via Trani 1, Milano

Indoor 50m x 8 lanes pool for competition

Indoor 25m x 5 lanes pool for warming up and swimming down

**WHEN:** February, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> 2012

WHO: Athletes born before 1992 (males) and 1990 (females)

#### FRIDAY (3RD) PROGRAM:

The competition starts at 5.00 pm (warm up 4.00 pm):

200m freestyle

200m breastroke

200m backstroke

200m butterfly

800 freestyle W

1500 freestyle M

#### **SATURDAY (4TH) PROGRAM:**

The competition starts at 9.30 am

The competition starts at 3.30 pm

(warm up 8.30 am): (warm up 2.30 pm):

50m butterfly 400m freestyle

100m backstroke 100m butterfly

50m breastroke 50m backstroke

100m freestyle 100m breastroke

400m medley 50m freestyle

200m medley









#### **RULES**:

- Swimmers can only compete in three individual competitions
- In 400m freestyle and 400m medley will compete 16 athletes with best entry times
- Heats will be swum seeded by entry times, starting from the slowest
- Points are awarded to the fastest 8 swimmers in each event (1 point to the 8th, 9 points to the 1st)
- The competition runs under the rules of the Italian Swimming Federation (Federazione Italiana Nuoto).

#### **ENTRIES**:

- Deadline for entries submission is January 15th.
- Entry times must be performed in 25m pool.

#### **AWARDS**:

- The first 3 athletes of each competition will be awarded with medals
- There will be a separate ranking for clubs. The winning club will receive the "Città di Milano" Trophy
- The coach of the 1st classified club will be awarded with € 500 , the coach of the  $2^{nd}$  club with € 300, the  $3^{rd}$  with € 200.
